



TWIN LAKES PARK





Before beginning your run, look down the snow run to be sure the previous rider has safely exited the snow run and your lane is clear. Do not begin your run until all earlier riders have exited the snow run.

Only one tube or sled is permitted in each run at one time. Upon reaching the bottom immediately exit the snow run to the right so the next rider can begin. After exiting right, turn right and walk back to the top of the snow run using the elevated area on the right side of each run.

Riders must remain in one snow run. Travelling from one snow run to the next or across snow runs is not permitted.

Only one rider per tube or sled at any time.

To control your speed, ride on your stomach and drag your feet. It is recommended that you take your first run prepared to drag your feet as snow tubing & sledding conditions vary constantly because of use & changing weather conditions.

Throwing snow balls or ice is not permitted and will not be tolerated.

This facility will be open from 9:00 am to dusk.

The snow tubing & sledding area is self-policing. Please be courteous to all other users and all other park patrons.


This park is a drug free recreation area.


The following are not permitted in the Snow Tubing & Sledding area:
