Westmoreland County Firemen's Association

The following rules and regulations are hereby listed for the Convention Host holding the Westmoreland County Firemen's Annual Convention.

- 1. Registration will not exceed the maximum of \$5.00 per person, which will include a pen and program book. Souvenirs shall be extra.
- 2. Convention Host shall be responsible for printing their own program and soliciting all ads. Convention Host shall receive all profits derived from such program. Westmoreland County Firemen's Association will take a full page advertisement in program book.
- 3. Convention Host shall provide suitable room for Thursday night Mohawk Dinner and meeting; Friday night meeting facilities and/or church; and Saturday morning executive reorganization meeting.
- 4. Convention Host shall furnish Past Presidents and Officers luncheon on Saturday at 11:00 am after the reorganization meeting.
- 5. Convention Host shall make arrangements for Memorial Service, working with the Association Memorial Committee.
- 6. Memorial services will be held at the expense of the Convention Host; with the exception of printing of Memorial Program and cost of wreath.
- 7. Convention Host shall make arrangements with the Campers Committee with the following to be provided: a facility to tap in for water and electricity. A restroom, if not available indoors, a porta-john will be acceptable.
- 8. It is mandatory that the Convention Host shall make arrangements for the parade in conjunction with the County Parade Committee and shall be held no later than 1:00 pm.
- 9. Parade route should be no longer than 2 miles in length.
- 10. Convention Host may provide cars for the Officers of the County Association participating in the parade.
- 11. Convention Host shall incur all expenses for the parade i.e. prizes, judges, decorations and advertising.
- 12. Last 3 companies hosting Convention shall lead the parade, followed by the Mohawks. No expense of convention is to be incurred by the County Association unless approved prior to convention.

Rules have been established and listed in the minutes of meetings of October 1969, June 1987. June 1988, June 1989 and June 2006. Proper action was taken on these rules by the Association.
