Five Star Trail Rules

- You are a welcome guest. Please follow these simple rules and use common sense, courtesy, and caution.
- Trail is open daily, dawn to dusk. No overnight use is permitted.
- No motor vehicles are permitted, except motorized wheel chairs. Call 724-872-5586 for a handicapped access permit.
- Share the trail. Keep right and pass on the left.
- Bicycles yield to walkers.
- Walkers please walk single file and to the right.
- Give verbal warning when overtaking other trail users.
- All pets must be on 6' leash and under control. Clean up after your pet.
- Dumping and littering are prohibited. If you see litter please pick it up.
- Please respect private property. Stay on the trail.
- No horses are permitted.
- Permits are required for special group events. Call 724-872-5586.

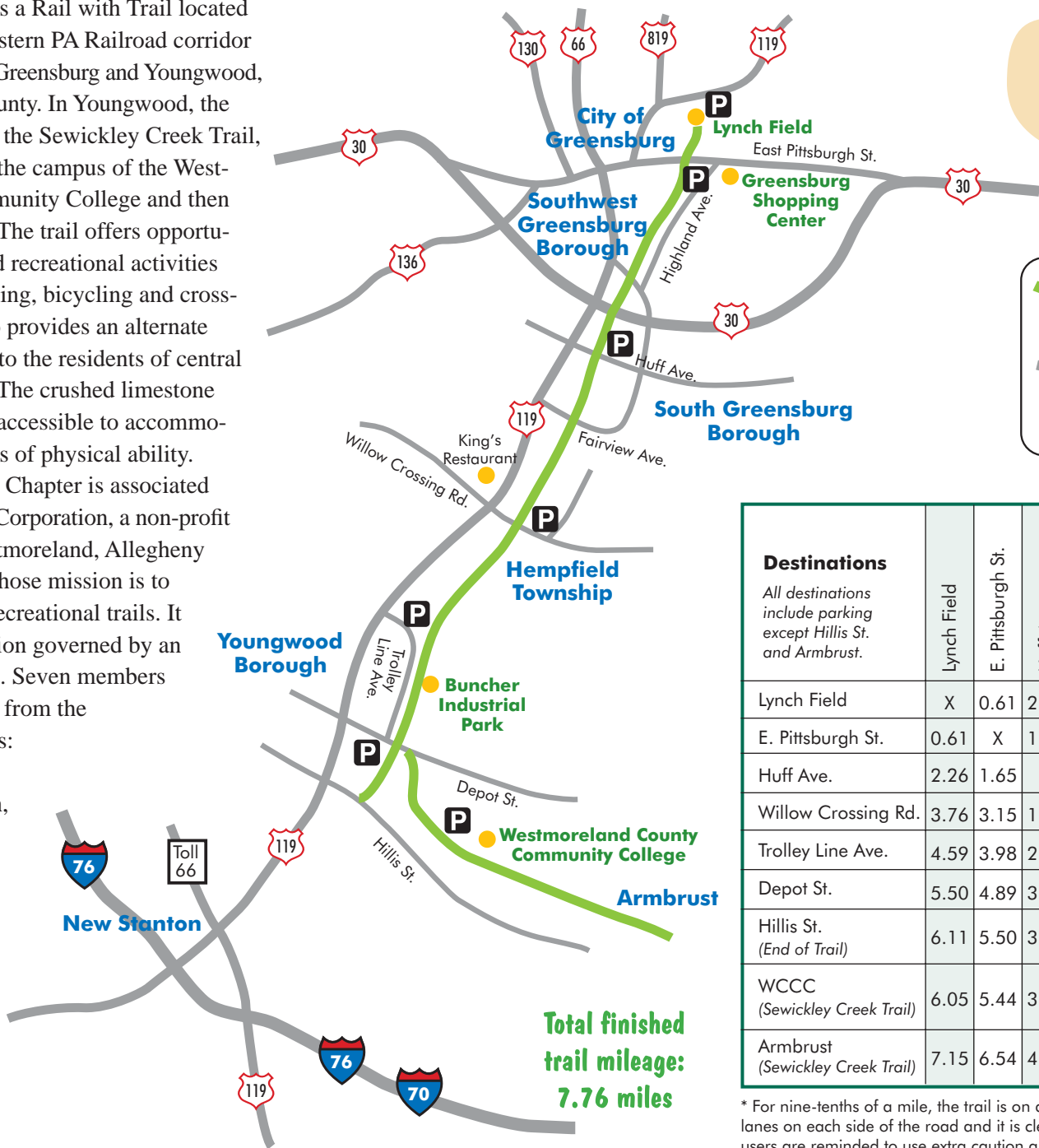

Get Out and Enjoy The Five Star Trail

The Five Star Trail is a Rail with Trail located along the Southwestern PA Railroad corridor between Lynch Field in Greensburg and Youngwood, PA in Westmoreland County. In Youngwood, the Five Star connects with the Sewickley Creek Trail, which leads through to the campus of the Westmoreland County Community College and then continues to Armbrust. The trail offers opportunities for non-motorized recreational activities including walking, jogging, bicycling and cross-country skiing, and also provides an alternate transportation resource to the residents of central Westmoreland County. The crushed limestone surface is handicapped accessible to accommodate everyone regardless of physical ability.

The Five Star Trail Chapter is associated with the Regional Trail Corporation, a non-profit corporation within Westmoreland, Allegheny and Fayette Counties whose mission is to construct and manage recreational trails. It is a volunteer organization governed by an eighteen-member board. Seven members are appointed, one each from the following municipalities: Greensburg, Hempfield Township, New Stanton, South Greensburg, Southwest Greensburg, Youngwood and Westmoreland County. The remaining board members are elected by the membership. In addition to the board, the trail is supported by the members.
