Consider approval of the minutes of the Election Board held June 23, 2021, as presented.

Opportunity for Public Comment

Under Section 10.1(a) of the Sunshine Act:

“ . . . the board or council of a political subdivision . . . shall provide a reasonable opportunity at each advertised regular meeting and advertised special meeting for residents of the political subdivision . . . or for taxpayers of the political subdivision . . . to comment on matters of concern, official action or deliberation which are or may be before the board or council prior to taking official action. The board or council has the option to accept all public comment at the beginning of the meeting.”

[This comment period may be deferred to the next public meeting of the board if there is insufficient time to hear such comments.]

- 4) Consider approval of the Election Bureau Staff and those employees temporarily assigned to the Election Bureau to the Mail-In and Absentee Board to do the Pre-Canvassing for the November 2, 2021 Municipal Election and to convene on November 2, 2021 at 7:00am.
- 5) Consider approval of the Election Bureau Staff and those employees temporarily assigned to the Election Bureau to the Mail-In and Absentee Board to do the Canvassing of Mail-In and Absentee ballots for the November 2, 2021 Municipal Election and to convene immediately following the close of the polls on November 2, 2021 and continuing thereafter until completed.
