General Primary Election of May 17, 2022

The Westmoreland County Board of Elections met in Regular Session on Tuesday, May 31, 2022 at the Westmoreland County Courthouse, Meeting Room #101 2 North Main Street, Greensburg, PA. The following were present: Chairman Sean Kertes, Vice-Chairman Douglas W. Chew, Secretary Gina Cerilli Thrasher and Assistant County Solicitor Christopher Nichols.

The following business was conducted:

Mr. Kertes called the meeting to order at 11:01am and led the Pledge of Allegiance

2) Mail-In and Absentee Ballots, which require Election Board Review
