

JUVENILE DETENTION BOARD MEETING

June 28, 2021 @ 10:00AM

Members Present: Commissioner Sean Kertes, Commissioner Gina Cerilli-Thrasher, Commissioner Doug Chew, Controller Jeffrey Balzer, Sheriff Albert, and Judge Bononi

Controller Balzer called the meeting to order.

A motion to approve the minutes of the March 28, 2021 meeting was made by Commissioner Kertes, and seconded by Commissioner Chew, Unanimous

Director Nicole Kamer gave the Director's Report.

A total admission for May 2021 was 10 residents. The Juvenile Detention has operated at 73% capacity for the month. The average daily population was 11.6 out of 16. There were 19 incident reports.

Four Youth Workers have been hired. Three of the new employees have already completed their training and working in the unit. The fourth new employee is completing his training this week.

Summer school starts tomorrow, June 29th, in both Detention and Shelter.

Covid: Zero residents have tested positive in the month of May 2021. To date, we have only had a total of 3 residents test positive. All staff and residents are still required to wear masks.

Training: All staff received 302 training through the Westmoreland Behavioral Health Office. The Department of Human Services is going to begin de-escalation training for all staff in the coming weeks.

Also discussed:

Lifting order for masks- Judge Bononi is okay with doing so.

Covid shots- talking with kids/parents to see if anyone is interested in receiving the shot.

Judge Bononi made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Commissioner Chew. Unanimous.
