Westmoreland County Board of Elections

Municipal Election of November 2, 2021

The Westmoreland County Board of Elections met in special session on Monday, November 29, 2021 at the Westmoreland County Courthouse, Commissioners Meeting Room #101, Greensburg, PA. The following were present: Commissioners Sean Kertes, Douglas W. Chew, Gina Cerilli Thrasher, Esq. and County Solicitor Melissa A. Guiddy. The following business was conducted:

Mr. Kertes called the meeting to order at 4:15pm

Motion was made by Mr. Chew, seconded by Mrs. Cerilli Thrasher and it was unanimously agreed to approve the minutes of the Election Board held November 22, 2021, as presented.

Opportunity for Public Comment

Ron Mozer, Monessen – was the only one on the ballot in November and received 2/3 of the vote, 1/3 of the vote was not for him, they were write-ins; he believes that he is a servant of the people and for whatever reason there were 550 write-ins and who they are for; many voted for the current mayor and 6 were for someone else who wrote it; he feels they should be published; he asks if there is ever an opportunity to county every single vote and put out there who they were for. Commissioner Chew states that Mr. Mozer has made an excellent point and confirms with Mr. McCloskey that we had over 22,000 write-ins in this election and not minimize it but that is really hard to count. Mr. Mozer stresses that every vote should count.

Motion was made by Mr. Chew, seconded by Mrs. Cerilli Thrasher and it was unanimously agreed to approve the Final Certification of the Election Results of the Municipal Election held November 2, 2021 for Judges of Election and Inspector of Election, notating the typographical correction.

There being no further business, motion was made by Mr. Chew, seconded by Mrs. Cerilli Thrasher and it was unanimously agreed to adjourn the meeting at 4:23pm.
