<u>Incident Details:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Westmoreland County Coroner, Kenneth A. Bacha, has released the following information on the decedents in the multiple fatality collision on the Pennsylvania Turnpike.▪ Chief Deputy Coroner Kirk E. Nolan, Deputy Coroner Joshua C. Zappone, and Deputy Coroner Doug Lewis investigated the incident and positively identified the decedents.▪ Autopsies will be performed by Dr. Cyril H. Wecht and Pathology Associates on January 6, 2020.▪ Toxicology results will not be available for several weeks.▪ Cause and manner of death will be pending autopsy results, toxicology results, and further investigation into the incident.▪ Multiple emergency medical personnel and local fire departments assisted in the incident.▪ Pennsylvania State Police New Stanton Barracks also investigated and will release additional details at their discretion.
