Bacha, has released the following information on a motorcycle fatality that occurred in Irwin Borough.</li><li>▪ The decedent, Glenn W. Hauliska, Jr., was the operator and lone occupant of a 2010, Harley Davidson motorcycle, traveling west on U.S. 30.</li><li>▪ A 2009, Jeep Patriot, attempted to make a left turn onto U.S. 30 east.</li><li>▪ The motorcycle collided with the driver's side of the Jeep Patriot in a t-bone type collision.</li><li>▪ The decedent was separated from the motorcycle.</li><li>▪ Deputy Coroner Sean R. Hribal pronounced the decedent dead at the scene.</li><li>▪ The decedent was utilizing a helmet at the time of the incident.</li><li>▪ An autopsy was performed by Dr. Cyril H. Wecht and Pathology Associates on July 19, 2020.</li><li>▪ Cause and manner of death is reflected above.</li><li>▪ Toxicology results will not be available for several weeks.</li><li>▪ Nickels Funeral Home of Herminie will be in charge of arrangements.</li><li>▪ Irwin Borough Police also investigated.</li></ul>
