- Westmoreland County Coroner, Timothy Carson, has released the following information on a vehicle/pedestrian fatality that occurred in East Huntingdon Township.
- The decedent, Brian P. Hyde, was a pedestrian at the above incident location.
- A 2019, Dodge Ram, traveling south on Water Street failed to negotiate a left curve in the roadway, traversed the west edge of the street, and struck the decedent as he was operating a snow blower.
- Emergency medical personnel responded to the scene and transported the decedent to Excela Frick Emergency Department, where he was pronounced dead by a hospital physician.
- Deputy Coroner Sean R. Hribal investigated the incident.
- It is unknown at this time if weather conditions, speed, and/or cellular phone use was a factor in the incident.
- An autopsy is scheduled with Dr. Cyril H. Wecht and Pathology Associates on March 14, 2022.
- Cause and manner of death will be pending autopsy and toxicology results.
- Toxicology results will not be available for several weeks.
- Kapr Funeral Home of Scottdale will be in charge of arrangements.
- Pennsylvania State Police Greensburg Barracks also investigated.
