| <u>Incident Details:</u> Cause of Death: Multiple Blunt Force Trauma Due to: Vehicle/Train Collision Manner of Death: Accidental <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Westmoreland County Coroner, Timothy Carson, has released the following information on a vehicle/train collision that occurred in Sutersville Borough.▪ A train traveling west cleared the intersection at 4th Avenue.▪ The decedent then began to travel through the railroad crossing.▪ The decedent's vehicle was struck by a train traveling east through the crossing.▪ Deputy Coroner Steven M. Grabiak pronounced the decedent dead at the scene.▪ The train initiated its brakes and horn upon approaching the crossing.▪ It appears the decedent disregarded the railroad traffic signal.▪ Cause and manner of death is reflected above.▪ Toxicology results will not be available for several weeks.▪ McCauley Funeral Home of West Newton is in charge of arrangements.▪ Pennsylvania State Police Greensburg Barracks and CSX Railroad Police also investigated. <p>***** <u>No further information is available from this office at this time.</u> *****</p> | |
