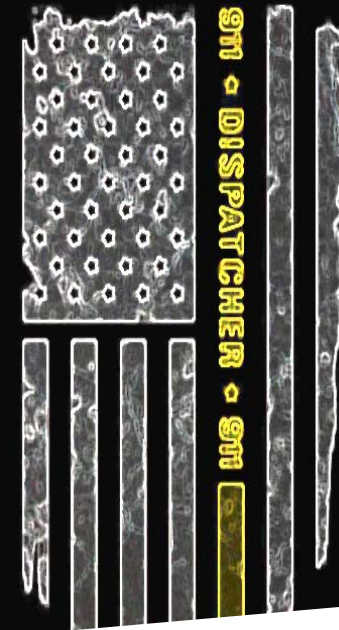

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

To make certain that we are hiring the best candidates, we require a thorough hiring process and training program to make you the best you can be.

- High School Diploma / GED equivalent
- Valid Drivers License
- Must acquire and maintain NCIC access throughout employment
- Ability to multi-task during stressful situations
- Capable of accurately typing minimum 35 WPM
- Ability to work nights, weekends and holidays
- Ability to follow directions under fast-paced environment
- Capable of reacting promptly under time sensitive situations
- Familiar with Windows based operating programs
- Ability to sit / stand for 12-16 hour increments
- Ability to clearly communicate with police, fire and EMS agencies

1 APPLICATION

2 TESTING – TEST GENIUS

- Setup an appointment to come visit the 911 Center or approved testing facility to take a computerized test that examines the test taker's ability to multi-task, enter data during a simulated environment.

3 TYPING TEST

- Must be at a County approved terminal and type a minimum of 35 WPM (see website)

4 INTERVIEW

- Panel interview of applicant

5 BACKGROUND CHECK

- Westmoreland Detective investigation and interview
- Process take 2 – 4 weeks
- See typical disqualifiers prior to beginning process (see website)

6 DRUG SCREENING

- Controlled substance screening

7 HEALTH EXAMINATION

- General doctors physical wellness exam
- Eyesight examination
