



Final Phase of Work to Begin at Jeannette Glass Site

GREENSBURG, PA, April 18, 2019 - The Westmoreland County Industrial Development Corporation (WCIDC) announced today the final phase of work at the Jeannette Glass site will begin on Monday, April 22.

This phase will consist of daylighting a portion of Old Bull Run Tunnel that runs along the Jeannette Glass site from Bullitt Avenue to Cassatt Avenue. Additional work will include the replacement of a pipe from Cassatt Avenue to Brush Creek. Curry & Kepple Inc. will perform work at the site.

Daylighting will result in the naturalization of the stream channel, and any viable material removed during the process will be used to build landscape mounds. In addition trees and shrubs will be planted in this area.

“On behalf of my fellow board members, we are excited to start this final phase of redevelopment and finish this priority project creating an opportunity for further private investment and job creation,” Gina Cerilli, Chairman of the WCIDC and Westmoreland County Board of Commissioners. “This project could not have been accomplished without the strong support of our city and state partners.”

WCIDC began work at the 13.2-acre site in 2017 with environmental remediation and demolition. Site preparations, including excavation, compacting soil, and the planting of grass, was completed in 2018.
