What are Family Based Mental Health Services? Family Based Mental Health Services (FBMH) program are comprehensive services provided by a team of two child mental health professionals or one child mental health professional and are delivered in the home and/or community. Family Based MH services includes intensive home therapy, casework services, family support services, and 24 hour/7 day availability for crisis stabilization.

- Complete the Beacon Pre-Certification form-include as much family and child demographic information and contact information as possible so the provider may contact the family
- Include the evaluation or recommendation letter for Family Based Mental Health Services
- ***If county funding is needed, the child must be enrolled (open) to the base service unit. To schedule an intake and enrollment with Westmoreland Case Management & Support, the family may call 724-837-1808 to schedule an appointment***
