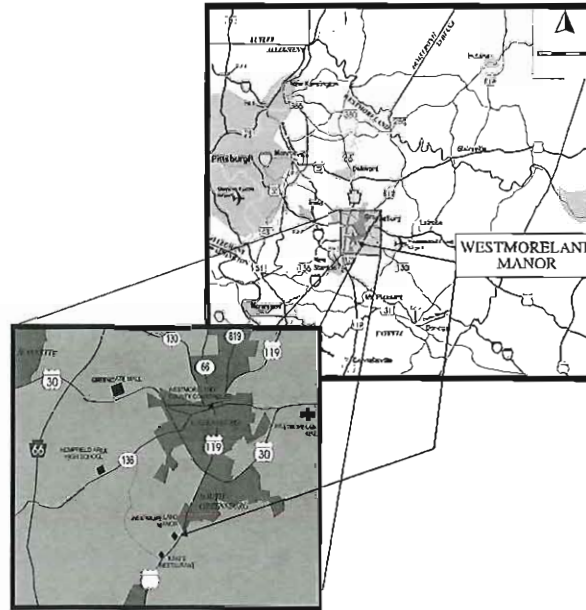
- ❖ Visiting hours daily at your convenience. Children are welcome.

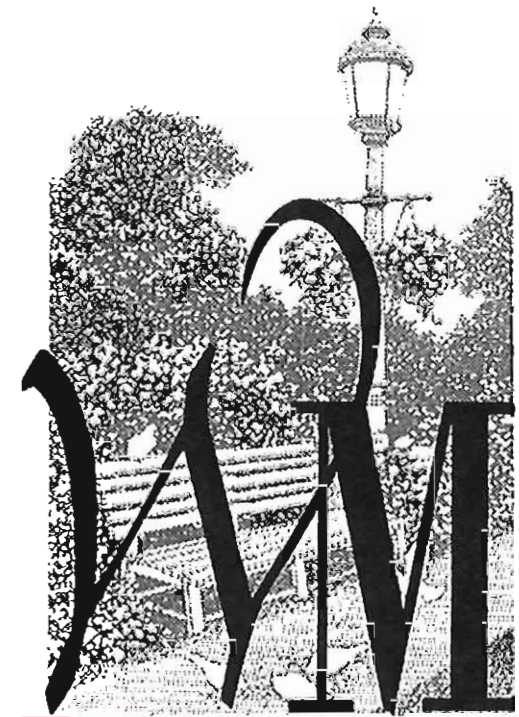


Directions

From East/West: Route 30 to Connellsville-Blairsville Exit. Bear right at exit (Route 119 South). Turn right at 3rd traffic light (South Grande Boulevard). Proceed up hill, turn right at stop sign and right again into Admissions Parking.

From North: Business Route 66 into City of Greensburg. Continue past Westmoreland County Courthouse. You will then be on Route 119 South. At 11th traffic light, turn right (South Grande Boulevard). Continue as above.

From South: Route 70 East turns into Route 119 North through Youngwood. Continue north past Kings Restaurant (on left). Turn left at next traffic light (South Grande Boulevard). Continue as above.
